## Adventure School / Abenteuer Schule

This etwinning project shall accompany our Comenius project. Under the project title "Adventure School" we want to develop and put into practice concepts which take place outside of the school building, which increase the motivation of our students to learn and which support them to identify with their schools. Another exciting aspect is the offer to solve action-oriented tasks together with young people from other European countries and to overcome language barriers. By solving these tasks each student can find his/ her place in the team. Success and acceptance of the performance of each single person increase self-confidence and self-esteem, especially with students who often fail in having success in the daily school life or who have problems to fit into a team. We want to fight school fatigue and give our students a perspective of being a part of the society, even abroad, and empower them to shape their own living circumstances responsibly and actively. Additionally an active contact to other cultures by students exchanges is the best possibility to widen one's horizon. To achieve these aims, we want to use elements of event/experiential education and transport them into the partner countries. Teachers of the partner school become familiar to the method and its educational background in workshops. The students will work in their own classes but as well in crosscultural groups to develop their competences. Students, teachers and parents will develop a criteria catalogue which will help to choose the students who are given the chance to take part in the minicamps. In national and international teams we will integrate the experiential elements into the school curriculum or give them a higher level.
