

Courses in English from nursery to high school aiming at educational excellence



The Anglophone international sections: taylor-made courses from nursery to high school



A single admission based on the successful completion of **entrance tests.**



A **bilingual and bicultural** programme based on a **bilateral pedagogical partnership** between the French Ministry of Education and foreign countries or organisations representing their education systems.



A course designed for pupils from foreign or binational families living in France which gives them the opportunity to **integrate the French school system whilst being taught in their first language**, together with French students having acquired a firstlanguage proficiency in English.



The acquisition of **sound language** and **cultural skills** in the Humanities.

Specific courses of study in English language and literature, and in History and Geography in English **taught by qualified teachers with a command of English at first-language level**.

International schools welcome their students **in the heart of Strasbourg**.

An international pathway **leading to world-ranked universities** both in France and internationally.



The British international section in Strasbourg

Pupils enrolled in the Anglophone international section **take additional and demanding examinations recognised internationally**:

- at the end of Year 10: the international option of the collège diploma (Diplôme National du Brevet "option international" – DNBI)
- **at the end of Year 11**: the International General Certificate of Secondary Education offered by Cambridge Assessment International Education
- **at the end of Year 13**: the British option of the International French Baccalaureate (BFI) equivalent to British A' levels and the French baccalaureate.



40% of BFI students study in Englishspeaking universities internationally, mostly in European countries after Brexit.
